2021 Junior Golf Program:

The 2021 program is being led by PGA Head Professional Adam Miller. The program has a long history of success at the Brockville CC, developing highly skilled players and teaching and coaching our kids to be outstanding individuals with proper golf etiquette, fair sportsmanship, and positive attitudes. The instruction focuses on teaching good golf fundamentals and techniques on full swing, driving, wedges, chipping, pitching, and putting. Each day the juniors are allowed to play on the course after their lesson. In addition, the kids enjoy meeting new friends and spending time socializing and other non-golf activities.

LEARN TO PLAY - INTRODUCTION AND DEVELOPMENT SESSIONS

Dates: TBD

Cost: Brockville CC Members (\$150) Non-Members (\$200)

- ❖ Open to members and the public.
- ❖ Ages 5 – 18.
- ❖ PGA of Canada - monitored and instructed
- ❖ Camps will operate on Saturday mornings for six weeks straight.
- ❖ Camps are 45min/1 hr per age group (6 x 1 hr sessions)
- ❖ The majority of camp time will be spent on the “practice facilities” at the Brockville CC.

Ages 5-7 start time 9am-10am

This age group focuses on making the **introductory stage** of golf an experience that will encourage further **involvement** and **development**. Basic golf etiquette, safety, and fundamentals will be emphasized in this camp at an introductory level. Parents are encouraged to attend and join in for this age group.

Ages 8-11 start time 10:15am-11:15am

This age group will also be focusing on the introductory level of golf but concentrating more on the fundamentals of the game - grip, stance, posture, alignment, balance, and more! Group-friendly competition is encouraged/recommended at this age, but fun and fair play is always the main objective. Basic golf etiquette will remain a significant focus for this age group, and parents are encouraged to attend and join in as well.

Ages 12-18 start time 11:30am-12:30pm

This age group will concentrate more on an increased social introduction to the game, focusing primarily on fundamentals and a general understanding of etiquette while at the golf course. Some “on course” play will also be incorporated in this age group at appropriate times.

Learn to Compete - ("Junior Plus" Camp)

Start Time: 10am-4pm Daily

Suggested age – 7yrs and up.

Cost: Brockville CC members (\$300) Non-members (\$350)

- ❖ Learn to Compete – Daily Competition is a focal point of this initiative.
- ❖ 5 Day Camp - Monday to Friday /6 hrs daily. 10:00am – 4:00pm
- ❖ Video Analysis is provided daily.
- ❖ Introduction and development of Social and Behavioural expectations while @ the golf course.
- ❖ Open to Membership and Public.
- ❖ Individual daily one on one assessment.
- ❖ Progressive benchmarks throughout the week.
- ❖ Golfers will enjoy other sports at times incorporated with golf systems to improve athletic movements.

This camp is designed to encourage further development of existing competitive players or players who are very seriously looking at becoming competitive. Most camp time will be “on course”; therefore, players must have experience completing 9/18 holes within the suggested round times.

Junior Golfer

Junior Golfer has not reached the age of 19 years old as of April 1st.

Junior Golfer Novice: Being of an age of 8 – 12 as of April 1 of the current year.

Family Junior: A junior attached to an adult member of the Club.

Independent Junior: A junior not attached by an adult family member of the club.

Junior Playing Privileges: Juniors may play on weekends and holidays after 1:00 PM, or between 11:00 AM and 1:00 PM if playing with a golf adult member. They may play after 8:00 AM on weekdays and book six days out.

Junior “Competitive”: Juniors that qualify will be listed as “Junior Competitive” status members. This will allow them the extra privilege of golf weekends and holidays after 11 am on weekends without adult members being with them. To qualify, juniors would need to be assessed by Golf Operations for proper skill development, maturity, and etiquette.
